CAREERS IN LATIN AMERICAN STUDIES

Entry level (AA): Front desk and support personnel at film festivals, art galleries, music events and arts organizations

Middle Level (BA): Mayor's Office of Cultural Affairs; New York State Council on the Arts (NYSCA) Personnel; Community Relations with Latin American business sponsoring the arts

Higher Level (MA and beyond): Teaching in higher education; government service (USAID); human rights organizations and NGO working with Latin America; Public relations positions with arts organizations at the local and hemispheric level; business consulting with global companies doing business in Latin America.
